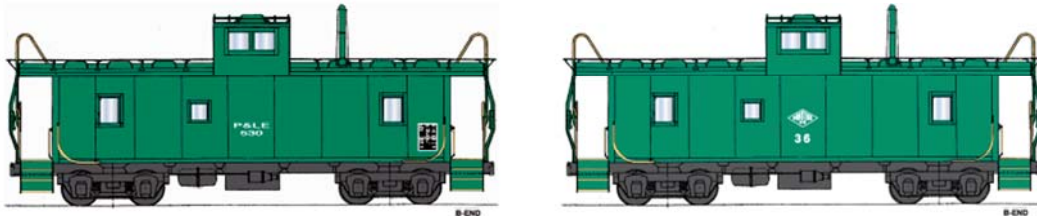

The **Pittsburgh & Lake Erie Railroad Historical Society** proudly announces the second "Project Car" offering for model railroaders.

In November, 1969, the Union Pacific Railroad sold eleven CA-4 cabooses to the P&LE. Seven went to the Montour, and two each to the Youngstown & Southern and the Pittsburgh, Chartiers and Youghiogheny. Eventually the P&LE bought back three of them in 1979 and 1981.

This car project utilizes **Intermountain Railway's CA-3** way car with appropriate paint and graphics. P&LE and Montour versions will come Ready-To-Roll and a painted/unlettered version will include decals for the Y&S and PC&Y. This decal set will also include Montour for those wishing additional numbers. **Both HO and N scale versions will be available. (Quantities are limited.)**

Delivery is expected in **May of 2012** and pre-orders are being accepted now. Road names and numbers available are: P&LE 530, P&LE 533, Montour 36 and unlettered.

Proceeds will be used to preserve the history of the Pittsburgh & Lake Erie Railroad.
